The plant is now fully constructed and we completed water commissioning on May 31, 2022. Our first product was produced this month on June 17th and the next 30,000 gallon batch is currently in the bioreactor. We hope to make around 90,000 gallons of product in June. Congratulations to the team on achieving this fantastic milestone for the company!

Field Trials

Sonia Nofziger-Dasgupta Director of Business Development

We are getting good reports from the AgriThority agronomist who is running our corn trials: "I am usually skeptical about expecting noticeable differences in fields that are managed under high inputs (the farmer standard here includes a number of Nutrien specialty products) but here we see consistently better standing corn on every side-by-side comparison across all 3 reps. These are especially noticeable when focusing on the low lying spots in the field that had been more affected by standing water early in the season. (Evidence of EnviroKure's ability to reduce abiotic stress impact from water logging.)"

The midseason corn report will be available by the end of July.
