

SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

MEDIA PROCEDURE GUIDELINES

These guidelines are meant to assist employees of EnviroKure, Inc when contacted by a representative of the state, local, or national media. Important note: all media requests, whether it be written, in-person, or over the phone, must be referred to Ann-Marie Adams. She can be reached 24/7 by phone at (607) 229-8071 or by email at am.adams@envirokure.com

Ann-Marie Adams will liaison with print, digital, and broadcast media representing EnviroKure, Inc. On a case-by-case basis, she may direct various employees to discuss issues that fall under their expertise with media representatives with approval from EnviroKure President, Joseph Steck.

When contacted or approached by a member of the media:

- Obtain the name of the media representative, their respective organization, all their contact information (email and phone number), and, if applicable, the deadline for their release of information to the public.
- Supply this information to Ann-Marie Adams, immediately.
 Media outlets oftentimes are working on extremely fast deadlines and will go elsewhere for information or release a story without comment from the company if their request is not handled in a swift fashion.
- Do not feel compelled to answer any questions, provide a statement, or conduct a phone or in-person interview. Avoid the use of "no comment," as it carries a negative connotation. Inform the media representative that you will refer all questions to a spokesperson for the company.
- Understand that there is no such thing as "off the record" when speaking to a reporter. Always operate under the assumption that anything you do or say can be reported.
